<p>Transmission through contact with someone who is showing symptoms of the virus</p>	<p>Anyone exposed to the person displaying symptoms may be exposed to the virus through cross-contamination</p>	<p>- All staff and readers who believe they are displaying any symptoms (as listed on the NHS website) before they come to the studio should stay at home, self isolate and contact NHS 111.</p>	<p>Ensure that all staff and readers due to be on site are aware that they should not travel to studios if displaying symptoms, and that they should return home immediately if symptoms develop while on site.</p>	<p>Producer Narrator</p>	<p>On-going</p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Any staff member or reader who starts to show symptoms while travelling to the studio or on site, should stop working immediately, return home avoiding public transport, contact NHS 111 and follow self isolation guidelines. - All surfaces in booth used by person showing symptoms to be deep cleaned and studio facilities to be closed immediately and not re-opened for a minimum of 7 days.
